Principal's June 19, 2017 Report



Academics

- The fourth graders took the New York State Science test. This includes the performance test which they absolutely love. These have been scored and sent in to the NYS Dept. of Education.
- There were a number of educational field trips. Kdg. went to Shelburne Farm, 3rd grade went to AuSable Chasm, K-5 went to see the ballet "The Nightingale Song". A number of our students performed in these ballets. Grade 2 released the salmon into the Saranac River on June 15.
- We had our end of the year field day on June 19. Meg Lawliss is to be commended for the fine job she did organizing the various activities. We are also grateful to the parents who came to help out. The students had loads of fun and lots of physical activity!
- PreK graduation will be tomorrow (June 20).
- Kdg.-Gr. 5 Moving Up Day Ceremony will be on June 21.
- According to the I-Ready testing, 94% of the students in K-2 are on level in Reading, and 80% on level in Math. We know where our focus needs to be for next year.
- In composition skills 93% of the K-2 students achieved the benchmark (Fox in the Box assessment).
